



IDTACe Regional Feis Registration

adopted April 25th 2021, updated May 1st 2022

REGISTRATION

Feis organizers must submit a registration form to the IDTACE Feis Registrar for approval of any new and established in-person or online feiseanna in the region, as well as requests for skips, temporary and permanent date changes. This form can be found at [IDTACE Feis Registration Form](#) or on our region's website.

Registration must be submitted no less than 6 months prior to the feis date. Once approved, registration fees must be paid within 30 days of the approval, and proper insurance (if applicable) must be submitted within 30 days of the feis. Original registration form may be edited to submit proof of insurance, or can be sent via email.

A CAD \$50 late registration fee will be charged if registering less than 6 months prior to the feis date. Due to COVID-19 challenges in 2021, this policy was temporarily adjusted to 30 days prior to the feis. *Due to COVID-19 challenges in early 2022, this policy was temporarily adjusted to 45 days prior to the feis up until June 30th. As of July 1st, and until further notice, this policy will be temporarily adjusted to 3 months (90 days) prior to the feis.*

Registration fee for a one day feis is CAD \$240. Registration fee for a two day feis is CAD \$320. Back-to-back feiseanna must register each feis separately, each as a one day feis. An online feis is considered a one day feis. *Since there are currently no COVID-19 restrictions in our region, online feiseanna are no longer allowed.* All registration/late fees are non-refundable. If a fee was paid to NAFC for 2020, but the feis was cancelled by municipal/provincial health authority due to COVID-19, the fee will carry over to 2021 or 2022 feis registration. If a usual 1 day feis must run as a 2 day feis in 2021 or 2022, no further fee will apply. *Since there are currently no COVID-19 restrictions in our region, full fees will be charged for a 2 day feis.*

If a fee is paid to IDTACE for 2021, but the feis gets cancelled by municipal/provincial health authority due to COVID-19, the fee will be applied to 2022 or 2023 feis registration.

100% Canadian/local adjudicators may be used while travel restrictions are in place. *Travel restrictions are no longer in place, so 1/3rd of adjudicators must be from outside of the region. An updated adjudicator/musician contract for 2022 must be used, and is available.*

ADMINISTRATION

The IDTACE Regional Feis Registrar will use a multitude of factors when determining the approval of a feis, including, but not limited to, location, proximity of bordering region feiseanna, the proximity to an established feis, the feis cap, feis format, established/recurring date etc.

The IDTACE Regional Feis Registrar reserves the right to deny a feis registration if it does not fall into the scope of any established criteria, or if it appears it will inhibit or interfere with an approved feis on the same weekend. If a feis registration is denied, an appeal can be made to Ryan Carroll, Regional Director, whose decision will be final.

Approval may also be revoked if fees are not paid within 30 days of approval or proof of insurance (if applicable) is not submitted within 30 days of the feis date.

FEIS REPORT

Organizers must submit a detailed report to the IDTACE Regional Feis Registrar within 14 days of the feis using the online form. [IDTACE Regional Feis Report](#)

Registration for any subsequent feiseanna will be denied if the previous report has not been submitted.

Information will be used to measure the financial and cultural success of all regional feiseanna, however, any sensitive details provided regarding financials or the like will be kept confidential.
